


Mirror Wall Sconce

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

This product has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug's orientation. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not force the plug into the outlet. Never use this plug with an extension cord unless the plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.

Parts Included:

- (A) Lamp body
- (B) Socket
- (C) Socket ring
- (D) Metal sheet
- (E) Shade (not included, sold separately)
- (F) Plastic washer
- (G) Mirror
- (H) Metal washer
- (I) Butterfly nut
- (a) Wall anchors
- (b) Screws
- (c) Paper template



Assembly Instructions:

- 1. Place one piece Plastic washer (F) onto the lip of Lamp body (A), make the lip of Lamp body (A) to go through the predrill hole into the Mirror (G) and place other Plastic washer (F) and Metal washer (H) onto the lip of Lamp body (A). Turing the Butterfly nut (I) in a clockwise direction till tight.
- 2. Place the Paper template (c) against the wall at the desired location and ensure that the template is level. Using a pencil mark the locations on the wall. This is where the hardware will be inserted.
- 3. Using the marks in the previous step as a guide, drill the holes for Wall anchors (a). Insert the Wall anchors (a) into the holes. Using a Philip's head screwdriver to fully insert until the Wall anchors are flush with wall.
- 4. Insert the Screws (b) into the Wall anchors (a), leaving approximately 1/2" between the back of the screw head and the wall.
- 5. Align the keyholes of Metal sheet (D) over the Screws (b), and slide the light fixture down until it rests on the screws.
- 6. Unscrew Socket ring (C) from the Socket (B)
- 7. Place a shade E (**not included**, **sold separately**) onto the socket (B), then secure it by turning the Socket ring (C) in a clockwise direction.
- 8. Insert a maximum (TYPE B) standard 40-watt light bulb (not included) or a 9-watt compact fluorescent bulb (included) into the socket (B)
- 9. Plug fixture into the proper outlet and test.

CAUTION:

This lamp uses a (TYPE B) 40-watt bulb (not included) or a 9-watt compact fluorescent bulb (included). To avoid risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended bulb wattage.

Care Instructions:

Wipe clean using a soft, dry cloth or static duster.

Do not use strong chemical or abrasive cleaners.
