

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

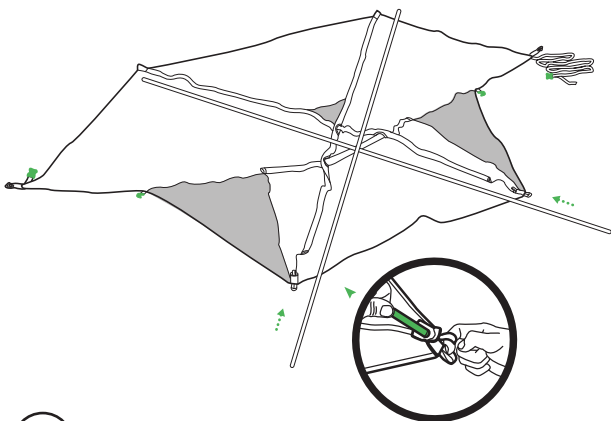
Outward Shade Shelter

Don't throw shade—set it up instead

Check inside the carry bag for:

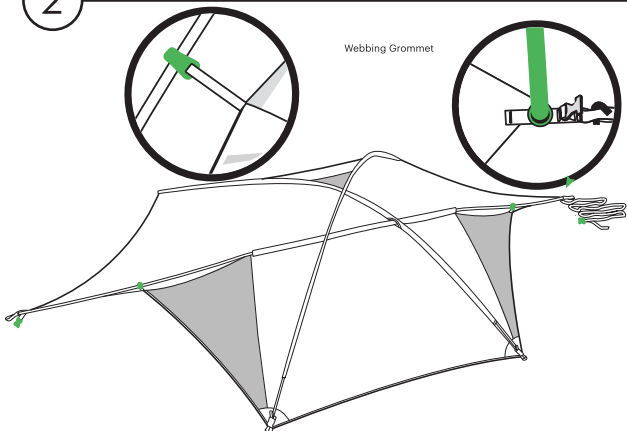
- Shelter body
- 2 straight poles
- 1 angled pole
- Stakes
- Guylines

- With the canopy flat on the ground, slide the two straight poles through the sleeves as shown.
- Once both poles are threaded through the sleeves, insert the ends of the poles into the pockets.
- **WATCH OUT!** As you place the poles in the pockets, make sure the shelter takes the shape of a DOME, not a BOWL. As long as the logo is on the outside of the dome, you've got it right!

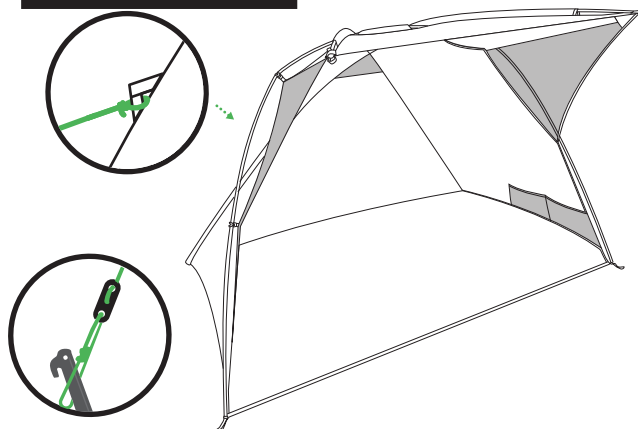
- Insert the pole with the two bends into the pole sleeve in the center of the shelter. Make sure the pole is threaded underneath the two tunnels of the first poles that have already been inserted.
- Secure the poles ends into the grommets as shown and attach all 2 pole clips along the length of the bended pole.
- The shelter will still be fairly flat at this point, but don't worry!

- OK, are you ready? Connect the plastic buckle on the long webbing strap to the plastic buckle on the short strap and watch the shelter take shape!

GUYLINE ATTACHMENT



- Find the loops on the outside of the shelter and knot the free end of the guylines to them.
- On the tightener end of the guylines, pull the line loose to make a loop and stake through it. Tighten by sliding the tightener toward the shelter.

TIP: Guylines are used to brace the shelter in windy conditions.
