Home game admission will be charged for all league games - including Sioux Falls vs Sioux Falls games. SFYHA Family Season Passes are \$40 with Adult Season Passes for \$25. You may purchase a Family Season Pass at the preseason events for \$35 (\$5 discount). Individual adult admission for home games is \$6.00. 

FUNDRAISER CREDIT OPTIONS - 2024-2025

As indicated on your registration, Mid-Season Fundraiser Fees are due January 13, 2025. Sioux Falls Youth Hockey will provide to SFYHA families "options" with which to earn FUNDRAISER CREDIT. Each player may participate in one, several, all, or none of the fundraisers listed. We will keep a record of each player's sales and calculate those credit totals to be posted on the website as of December 31 for each family. We encourage each family to keep a log of their fundraisers and credit earned.

- <u>"SCRIP CENTER" FUNDRAISER</u> The Scrip Center program is like "substitute money" with gift cards, escrip or certificates purchased to be used at businesses for payment of goods and services. SFYHA players will receive various rates of credit for the scrip. Some of the over 1000 businesses participating include Applebee's, Pizza Hut, Wendy's, Best Buy, JC Penney, Sams & Walmart, Barnes & Noble, Red Lobster, Buffalo Wild Wings, Dave & Busters and many more with credit earned ranging from 2% to 16%. Order forms for physical gift cards/certificates are available any time from Cherry Hunter or our website siouxfallsflyers.com. Orders for physical cards are placed on the 1st and the 15th of each month. This fundraiser can be utilized year-round with all paid orders placed by December 31 to be credited to this season's fundraiser fee. ALSO AVAILABLE escrip cards ordered through the Raise Right app! The escrip is a great mobile online ordering tool and can be done via your phone as you shop!! If you are interested in the Raise Right app please contact Cherry Hunter at cherry.hunter@sfflyers.com for SFYHA enrollment code and details! In addition to the "scrip" ordered from a national distribution center, Hy-Vee cards and Get-N-Go/BP cards are readily available from Cherry Hunter. Hy-Vee and Get-N-Go/BP are 4.5% credit. Starting January 1, all orders will be credited to next season's account for your player.
- AVENUE OF FLAGS CLUB New patriotic fundraiser option! Supporters can register online to become an Avenue of Flags Club member for either \$50 or \$100. Supporters will receive an American Flag on a portable stand to display on Memorial or Labor Day. They also receive a \$50 or \$100 gift card package that can be used to shop and save at various businesses. SFYHA volunteers will deliver and place the American Flag and portable stand during the morning hours of Memorial or Labor Day and return to take the items down later in the day. The online fundraiser will earn credit of 25% of sales made in the player's name

- <u>CHRISTMAS WREATH SALES</u> This has been a great success for the last 33 years. Take orders! Door size wreaths sell for \$21.00@ with \$8.50 credited to your FUNDRAISER CREDIT. The large wreaths sell for \$45 each with a credit of \$13.00 each. Wreath crosses sell for \$25.00@ with a \$8.50 credit and the Christmas Centerpiece has been a wonderful addition. Selling price is \$33 each with \$10.00 credit per centerpiece. The 25ft Garland Ropes sell for \$53 each with \$10 credit earned. Each door swag sells for \$18 with \$8.00 credit earned. Kick off for Wreath Sales will be at the September 15 Fall Kick-Off Event at the IcePlex. Order forms and information will be distributed at that time. Wreath Orders are due by October 26. Delivery of wreaths will be December 2 at the IcePlex.
- <u>CANDY BAR SALES</u> Sell candy bars for \$1.00 each profit is \$25 per box of 60 candy bars. We utilize World's Finest Chocolate candy bars. Candy bars will be available at the Fall Event at the IcePlex on September 10. Again this year, families will write a check for the candy bars received, the check will be held for 30 days and then cashed if no candy bars are returned. Each box contains 60 assorted chocolate candy bars. Caramel Only boxes are available this season!!!
- <u>FRIEND of FLYERS!</u> Secure donations or sponsorships for \$50-\$1000 and earn up to 50% of the contribution for fundraiser credit. Players will secure pledges for skated laps. 80% of funds collected will be credited to the player's fundraiser fee, with the remaining 20% used to pay for ice rental time. - **RAFFLE TICKET SALES!** Derek Berg has secured a great line up of raffle items! Players sell tickets for \$10 each and earn \$5 fundraiser credit per ticket sold.
