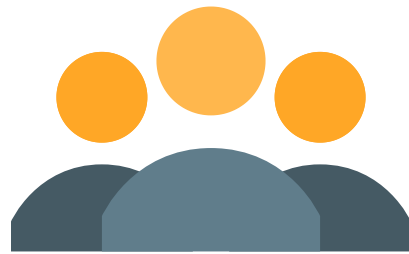

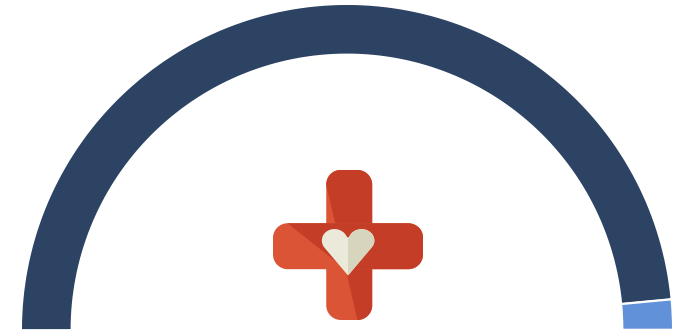

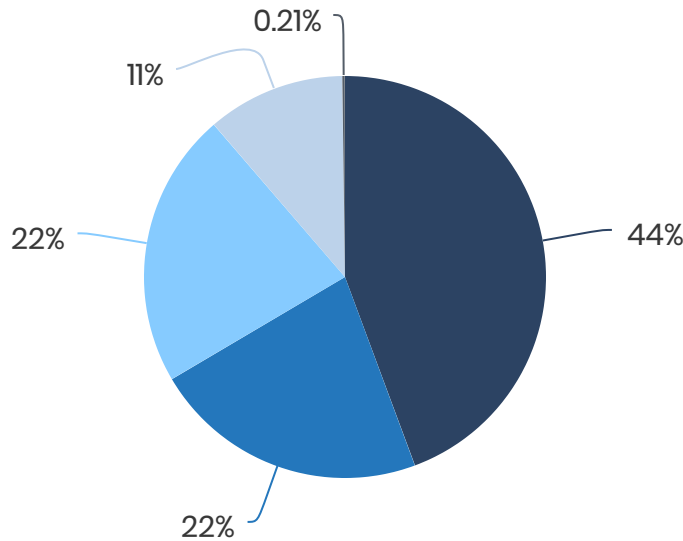

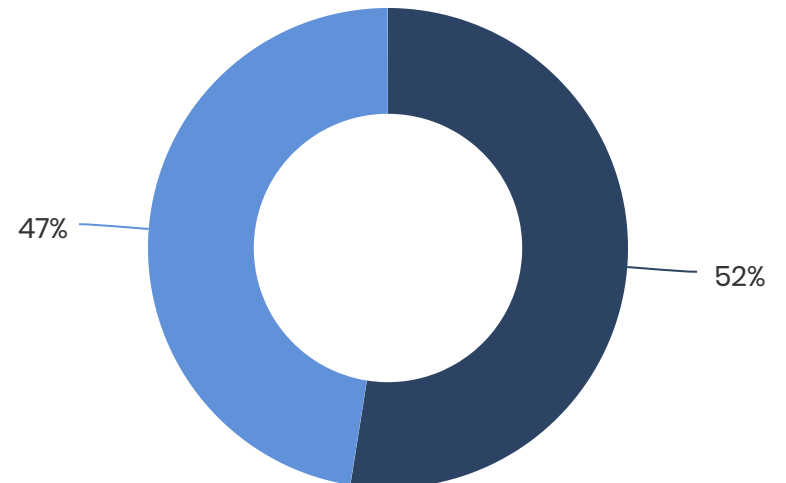

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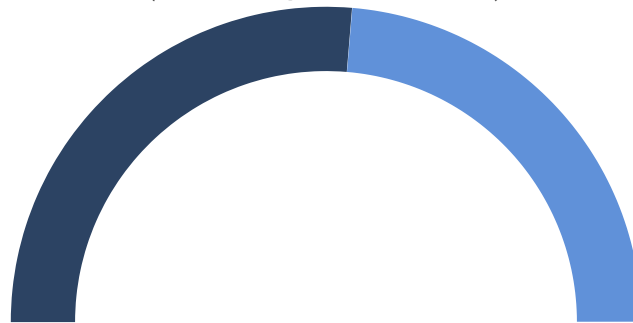

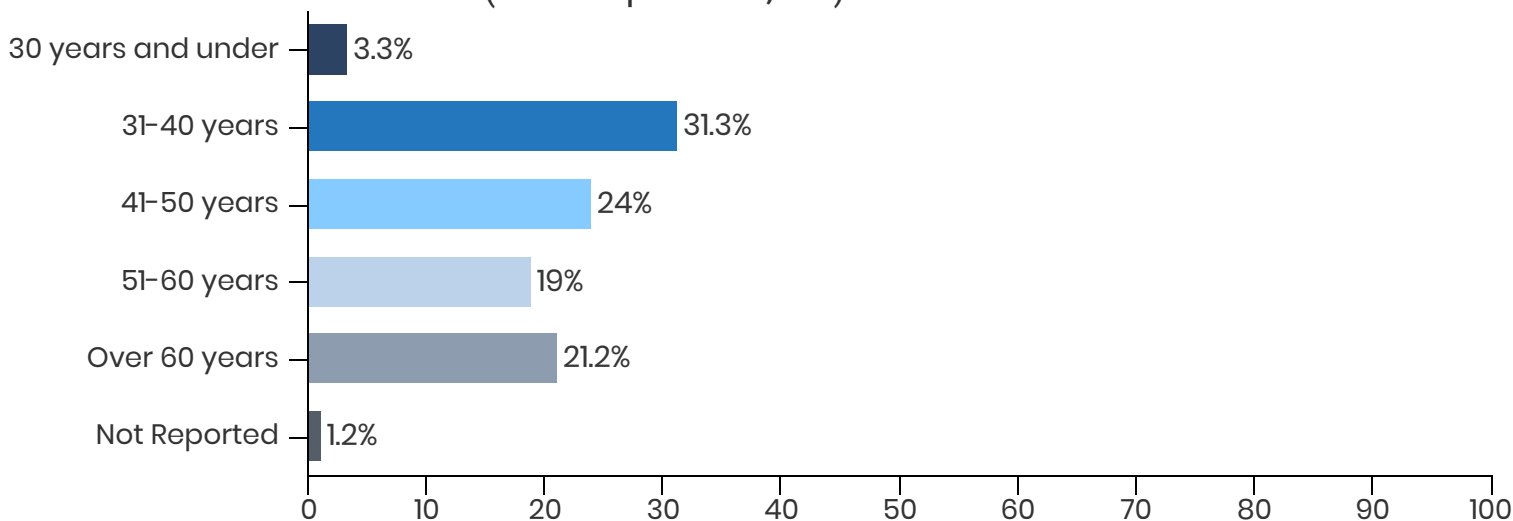

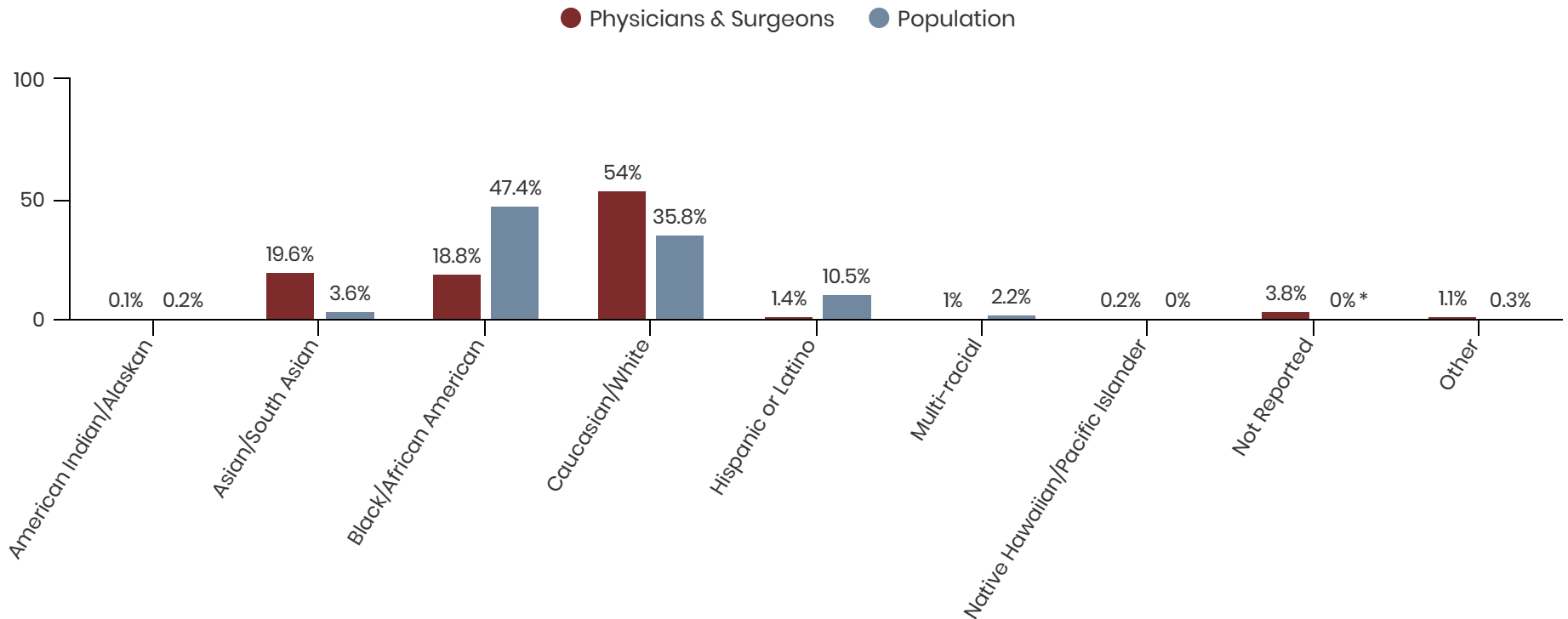

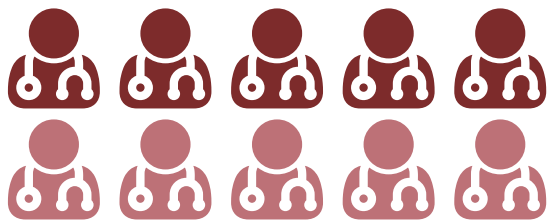

5 out of 10 practicing physicians in the District are Caucasian/White.

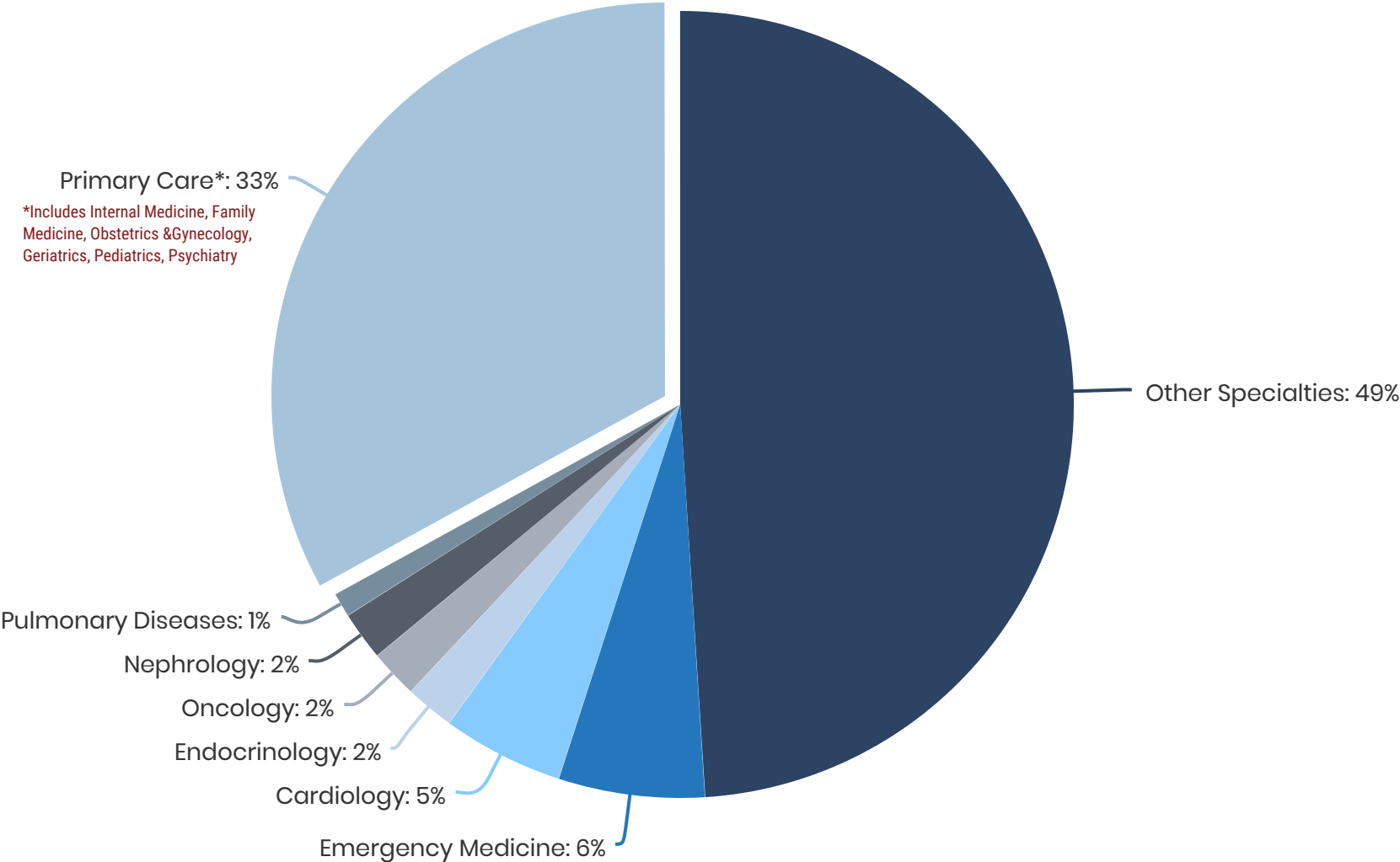


5 out of 10 District residents are Black/African-American.

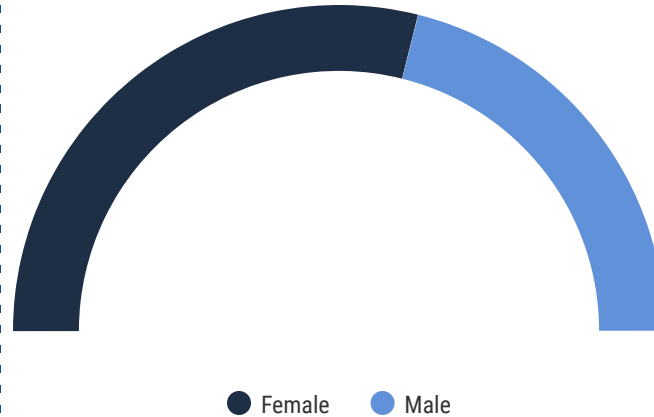

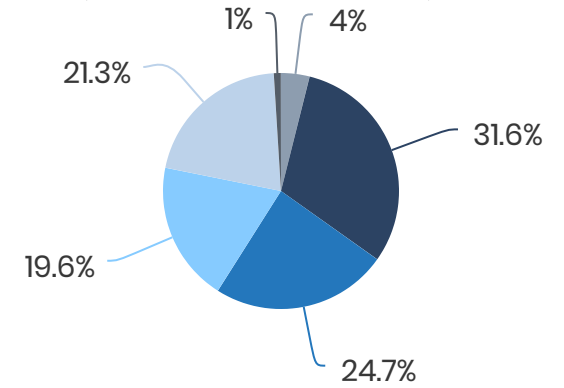

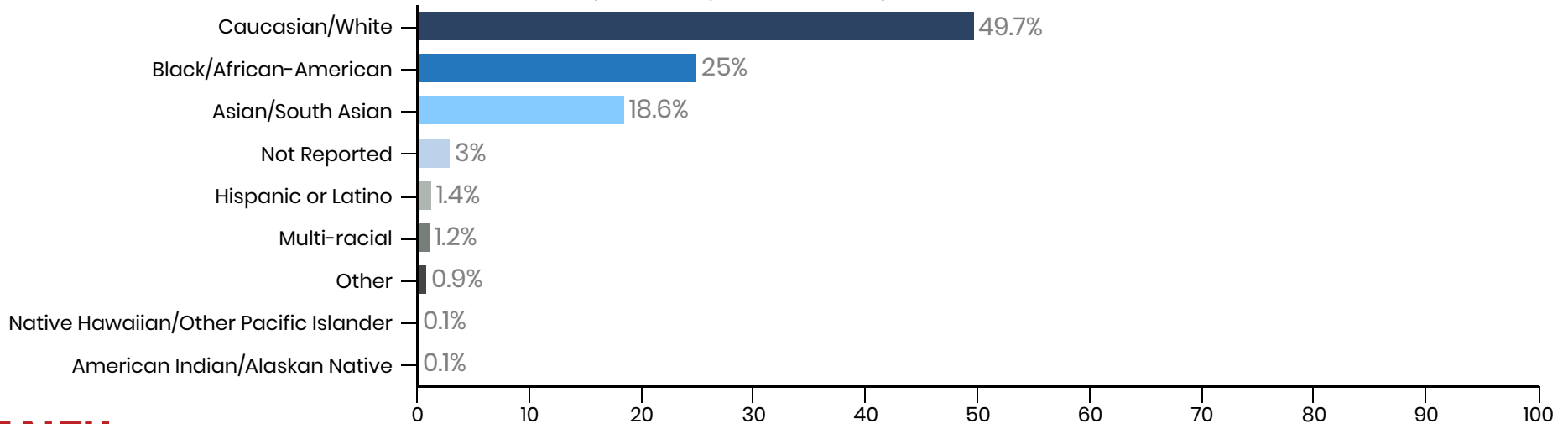

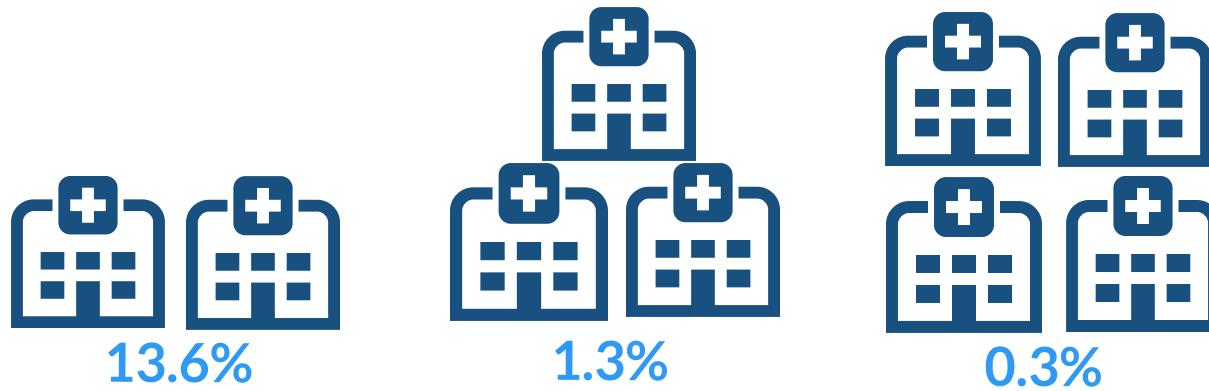

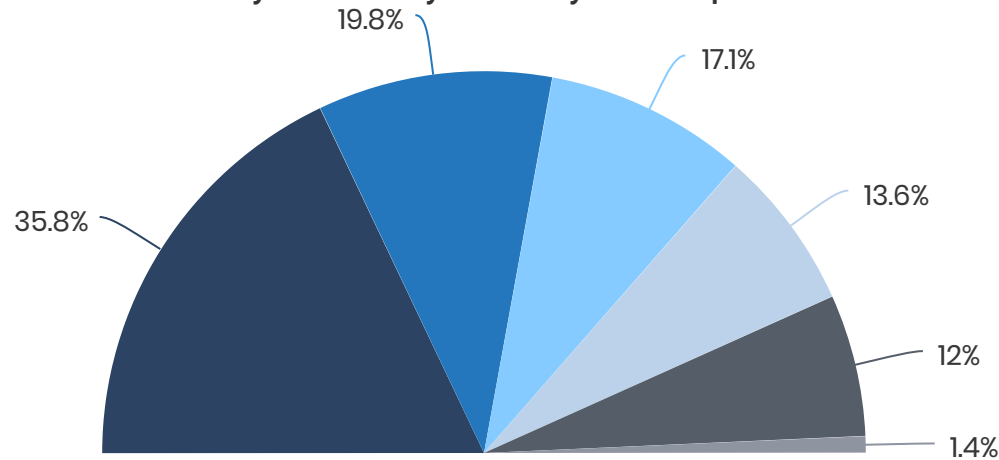
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Percentage of Physicians with Multiple Practice Locations

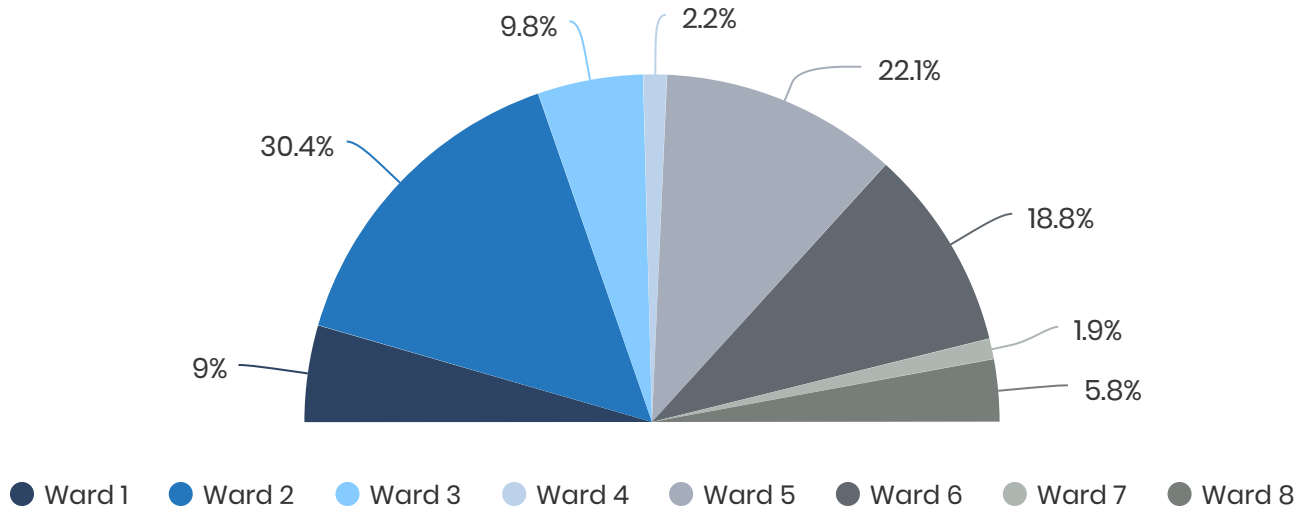
