

District of Columbia Board of Pharmacy MPJE Retake Policy

- Candidates are limited to five (5) attempts to pass the MPJE.
- An applicant that fails to pass the MPJE during the first three (3) attempts, shall be required to meet with the Board before the Board may approve the applicant for subsequent testing. If approved by the Board to retake the examination, the applicant shall be required to wait sixty (60) days from the date of last test before retaking the examination.
- An applicant that fails to pass the MPJE during the first four (4) attempts, shall be required to wait ninety (90) days from the date of last test before retaking the examination
- An applicant for licensure who does not pass the MPJE during the first five (5) attempts, shall not be approved by the Board for any subsequent attempts to retake the examination, and the Board shall not approve an application for licensure by examination, score transfer, or reciprocity if filed by the applicant within three years after a fifth (5) failed attempt.
