The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that, pursuant to Order No. 19676, the Commission will hold the eighth RM9 Net Energy Metering (“NEM”) Working Group (“RM9 Working Group”) Meeting on March 16, 2020. In accordance with Commission directives in Order Nos. 19676 and 19692, the RM9 Working Group will hold a meeting to further discuss NEM credits as they relate to the proposed generating thresholds for NEM systems for individual behind-the-meter generators increased beyond 100 percent of the customer’s historical usage. The eighth RM9 Working Group Meeting will be held from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. in the Commission’s Hearing Room – 1325 G St. N.W., Suite 800, Washington, D.C., 20005. Commission Staff shall preside over the working group meeting and file meeting minutes in the above-captioned dockets within ten (10) days of the meeting.
