PUBLIC NOTICE

FORMAL CASE NO. 1148, IN THE MATTER OF THE INVESTIGATION INTO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND ENERGY CONSERVATION PROGRAMS TARGETED TOWARDS BOTH AFFORDABLE MULTIFAMILY UNITS AND MASTER METERED MULTIFAMILY BUILDINGS WHICH INCLUDE LOW AND LIMITED INCOME RESIDENTS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1. On June 27, 2019, the Energy Efficiency and Energy Conservation (“EEEC”) Working Group filed with the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) its Report requesting that the Commission approve the issuance of a request for proposals to hire a Program Implementer to assist in finalizing specific details and manage the Whole-Building, Deep Energy Retrofit Program (“Retrofit Program”).¹ The EEEEC Working Group notes that the Implementer’s tasks are to assist in finalizing specific Retrofit Program details in conjunction with EEEEC stakeholders for submission to the Commission for approval, and to administer the Retrofit Program, until all of the approved whole-building deep energy retrofit projects are completed. The EEEEC Working Group also believes there is a need to ensure a process for stakeholder involvement and proposes two different options: (1) the Commission direct the utility to create a non-profit board composed of stakeholders; or (2) the Commission establishment of an EEEEC Task Force composed of stakeholders. These options are detailed in paragraphs 10 and 11 respectively, of the Report. In both instances either group would work with the Implementer to fully develop the Retrofit Program.

2. By this Notice, all persons interested in commenting on the EEEEC Working Group June 27th Report, including the options for stakeholder involvement or other retrofit program operational issues identified in the Report, may submit written comments, not later than 20 days, after the Commission’s issuance of this Notice.
