

Age Context for DHCF COVID Vaccination Data

- Within the DHCF population, vaccination rates differ in part due to varying age profiles
 - FFS average reflects older individuals who are most likely to be vaccinated
 - For younger groups, MCO rates are higher than FFS
 - Differences by MCO are also affected by age (e.g., HSCSN does not enroll older individuals)

Districtwide Context for DHCF COVID Vaccination Data

- Data that DHCF has on COVID vaccinations is likely an undercount, but under any scenario the share of vaccinated beneficiaries is low relative to Districtwide rates
 - DHCF had evidence of at least one vaccination for 55% of beneficiaries age 5+ as of 6/24/2022; in comparison, DC Health reported a Districtwide rate of 99% for this group as of 6/22/2022
 - DHCF relies only on actuals from immunization registry (DC and Maryland) and claims data
 - Districtwide rates include both actual and estimated data
 - Problems with federal estimates have inflated vaccination rates for all states
 - Using DC immunization registry data alone (excluding estimates), the Districtwide rate for those age 5+ would be 83% instead of 99%; this is still higher than DHCF's 55%
- Many unvaccinated District residents are likely to be DHCF beneficiaries
 - More than 40% of District residents are covered by DHCF programs, and many live in Wards 7 and 8
 where vaccination rates are lowest
 - DHCF serves a large number of children ages 5-11 who only became eligible for vaccination in late 2021
 - MCOs that enroll more than 80% of the DHCF population ages 5+ are key partners in efforts to increase vaccine uptake

Additional Context for DHCF COVID Vaccination Data

- DHCF's Medicaid vaccination rate is on par with (or higher than) other states publicly reporting
- Medicaid rates for <u>age 12+</u> as of late last year
 - DC at 46% with at least one dose as of early October 2021
 - Figures for other states as of September/October 2021
 - Oregon = 54%
 - Virginia = 46%
 - Utah = 46%
 - Arizona = 41%
 - Georgia = 21%
 - Idaho = 20%
- Medicaid rates for <u>age 5+</u> as of this year
 - DC at 55% with at least one dose as of mid June 2022
 - California at 57% as of end of April 2022
 - Washington at 46% as of mid June 2022
