



## District of Columbia Medicaid Managed Care Plan (MCP)

### National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) Accreditation Status

The District of Columbia contracts with five MCPs (as referred to as MCOs) for administration of Medicaid services to eligible District residents. To ensure MCPs utilize evidenced-based practices and operate effective case management programs, DHCF requires all MCPs to achieve NCQA Health Plan and Case Management Accreditation. In addition to Case Management and Health Plan Accreditation, MCPs have the option of applying for and achieving other NCQA accreditation and/or Distinction Programs. The table below highlights NCQA Accreditation status, and type of Accreditation/Distinction achieved by each Medicaid MCP in the District of Columbia.
