Agenda items include:

- **FERPA Deep Dive**
Improve your understanding of FERPA and the context for the law and reduce misconceptions and misunderstandings about FERPA.
- **Vetting EdTech**
This session will explore both the importance of and how online educational technology can be assessed for privacy protections and general compliance with FERPA.
- **Anatomy of a Hack**
This session will feature a real cyberattack against a simulated school. See firsthand how attackers pick out their targets, exploit vulnerabilities, and break into school data systems.
- **Data Breach Response**
Attendees will be faced with a simulated data breach scenario and must make the critical decisions in addressing an ongoing breach, avoiding pitfalls, and guiding an organization through the difficult and often murky issues facing organizations during that time.
- **What happens when you are hacked
Who do you call?**
This presentation will take you through a school district data breach and will provide participants with a step-by-step guide of who to call and additional resources available to districts to help prepare for –and survive – a cyber security data breach.
