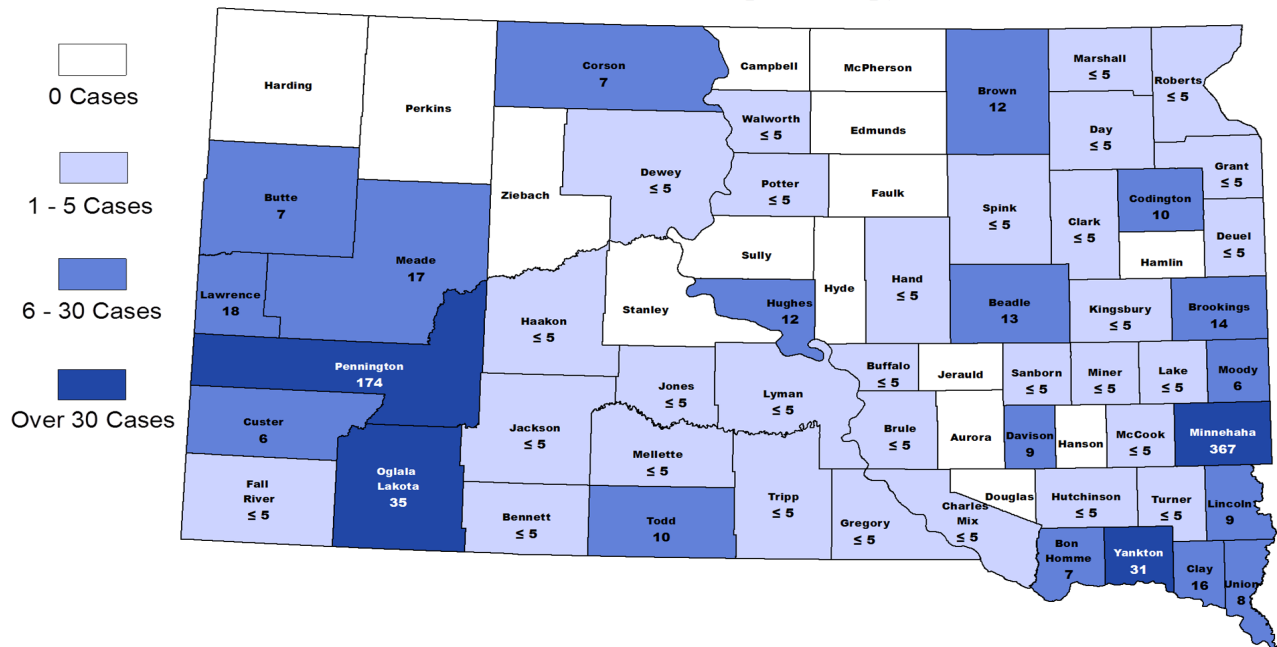


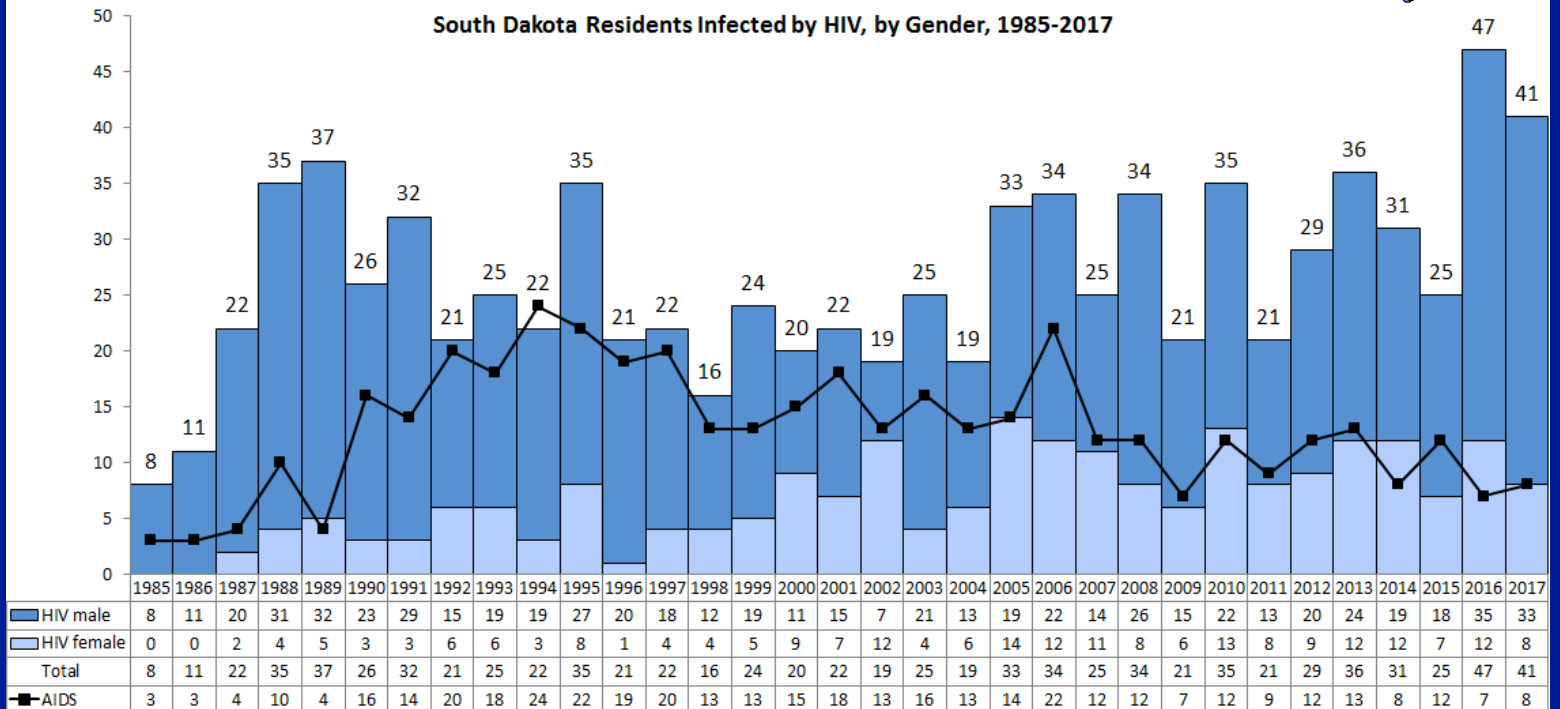

### 2017 STATISTICS

41 New HIV/AIDS cases were reported in 2017:

- 8 Females
- 33 Males

Disproportionately impacted by HIV/AIDS, diagnosis date, 2013-2017:

- Blacks: 24% of cases, 1% of the population
- American Indians: 19% of cases, 9% of the population

#### Late Testers:

Persons who are diagnosed with AIDS within 12 months of their initial HIV diagnosis, were 22% of all cases, 2013-2017
