

Substance Use Disorder Treatment Services

The Division of Behavioral Health accredits and contracts with substance use disorder agencies across the state to provide quality services to both adults and youth. Services include screenings and assessments, early interventions, detoxification, outpatient and inpatient treatment services. Financial assistance for services is available.

Outpatient Treatment Services

Outpatient treatment services provide counseling services to individuals diagnosed with substance use disorders. Also available on an outpatient basis are early intervention services for individuals who may have substance use related problems, but are not diagnosed with a substance use disorder. Outpatient services are able to be delivered via telehealth.

Low Intensity Residential Treatment Services

Low intensity residential treatment services include residential, peer-oriented treatment programs for individuals with substance use disorders whose living situation or recovery environment is incompatible with recovery goals. To prepare the client to live successfully in the community, the program provides substance use disorder counseling along with case management services.

Inpatient Treatment Services

Inpatient treatment services provide residential services with medically monitored intensive treatment for individuals with severe substance use disorders.

Detoxification Treatment Services

Detoxification treatment services are residential services delivered by trained staff who provide 24-hour supervision, observation and support for individuals who are intoxicated or experiencing withdrawal symptoms. Staff work to engage the individual in further treatment services following stabilization of withdrawal symptoms.

Specialized Treatment Services

Specialized treatment services are available for pregnant women, women with dependent children and individuals in need of intensive methampetamine treatment.
