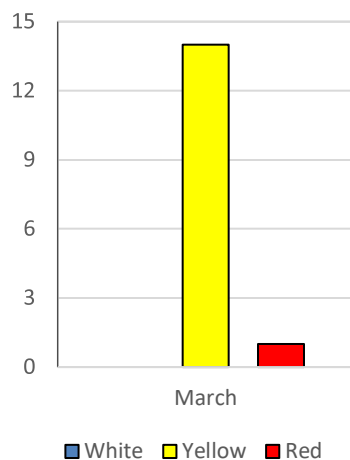

NOTICES ISSUED FOR SAFETY VIOLATIONS

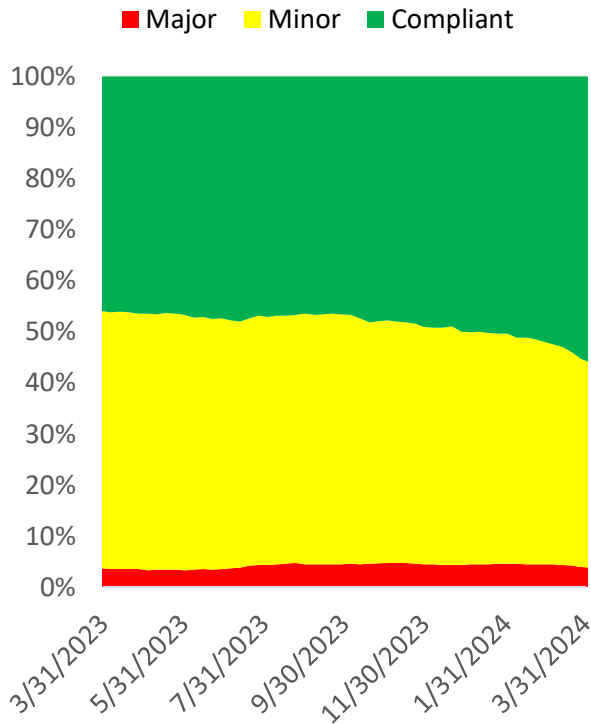
Fourteen yellow notices and one red notice were issued.



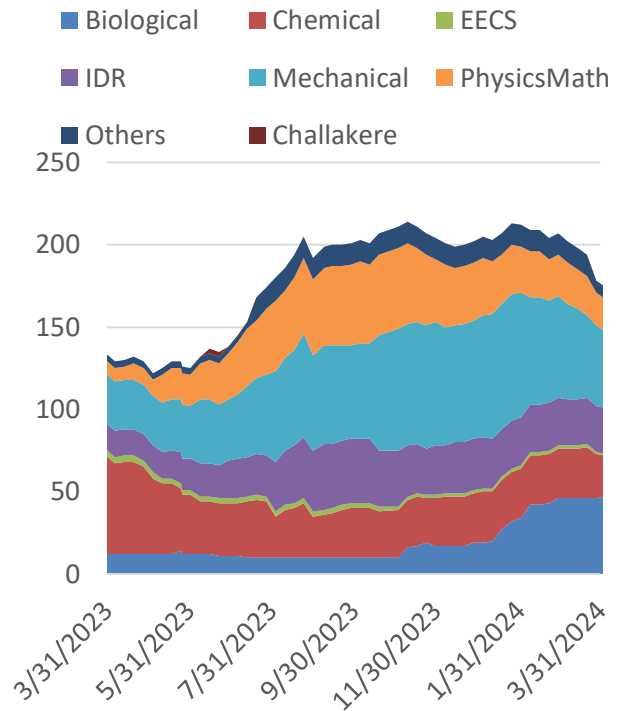
	Reason	OLSEH recommendation
1.	Unchained compressed gas cylinders inside the lab or gas cabinet.	All gas cylinders need to be chained as per the standards. The chain must either be half height or two chains at 1/3 and 2/3 height. (refer - https://olseh.iisc.ac.in/specialised-lab-safety/gas-and-cryogenic-safety/)
2.	For not addressing the recommendations of the lab safety audit report	If the violation is not remedied within the timeframe, OLSEH will send a yellow notice to the responsible PI or faculty for immediate action. For severe violations requiring immediate remedial action, the OLSEH office may directly issue a yellow or red notice.

LAB STATUS TRENDLINE

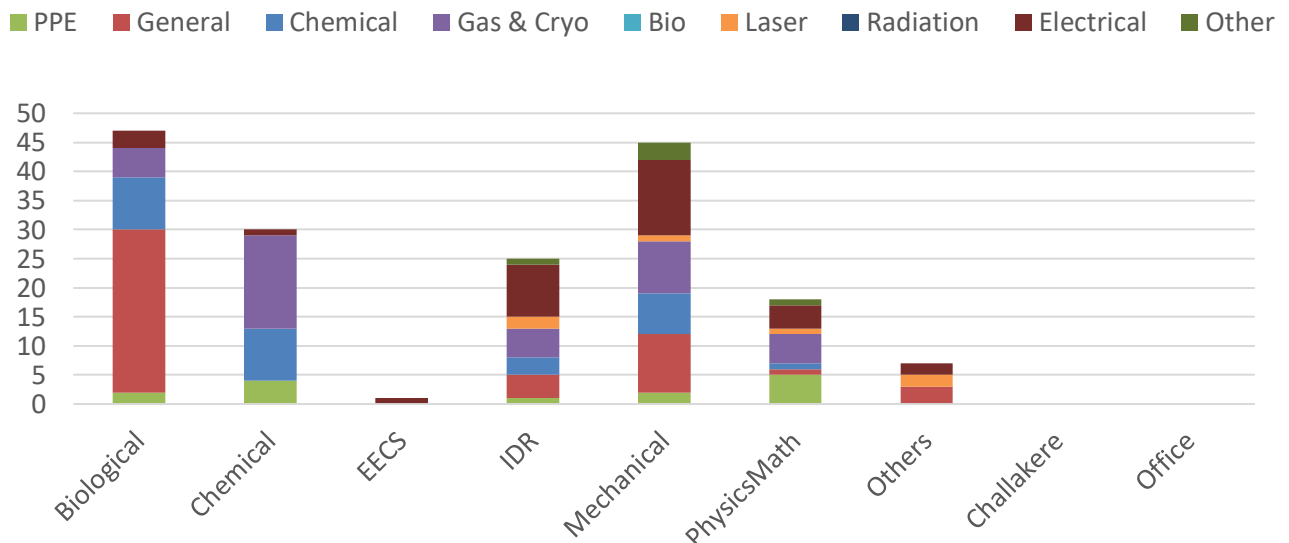

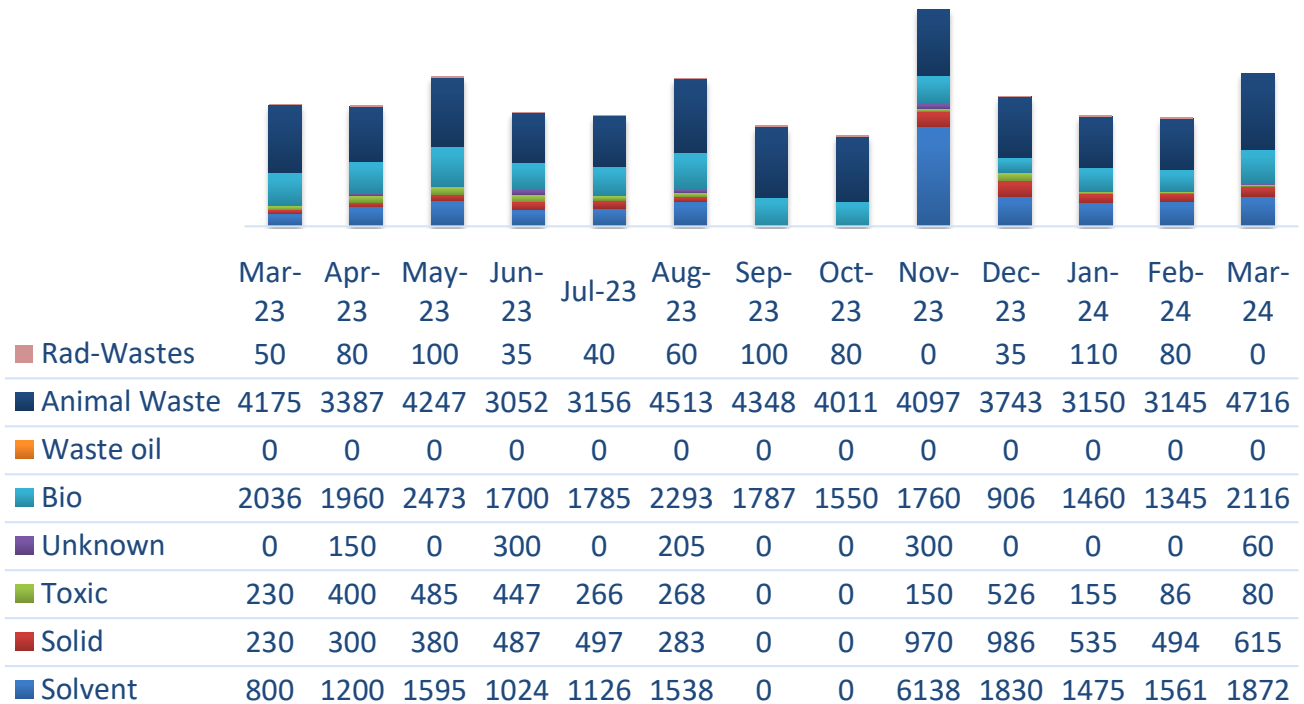
