

Train and Bus Routes from Washington, DC
Directions to Johns Hopkins Bayview Campus
NIDA / NIH 251 Bayview Blvd., Baltimore, MD 21224

According to Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) it takes approximately 1 hour to get to Baltimore on the MARC train and then approximately 30-40 minutes taking the busses to the Johns Hopkins Bayview Campus.

Traveling by MARC Train

- From Washington, DC take the MARC train leaving Union Station on the Penn Line (into Baltimore).

Fares effective June 27, 2021 per the legislatively-mandated fare increase schedule.

- Bus fare in Baltimore City is \$2 per trip, or \$4.60 for all day unlimited pass (all day pass recommended).
- Purchase your fare by using the CharmPass Mobile Transit Fare App or the MARC ticket vending machines that offer Apple Pay® and Google Pay, plus credit and debit options and transit subsidy and benefit programs (select locations accept cash such as West Baltimore).

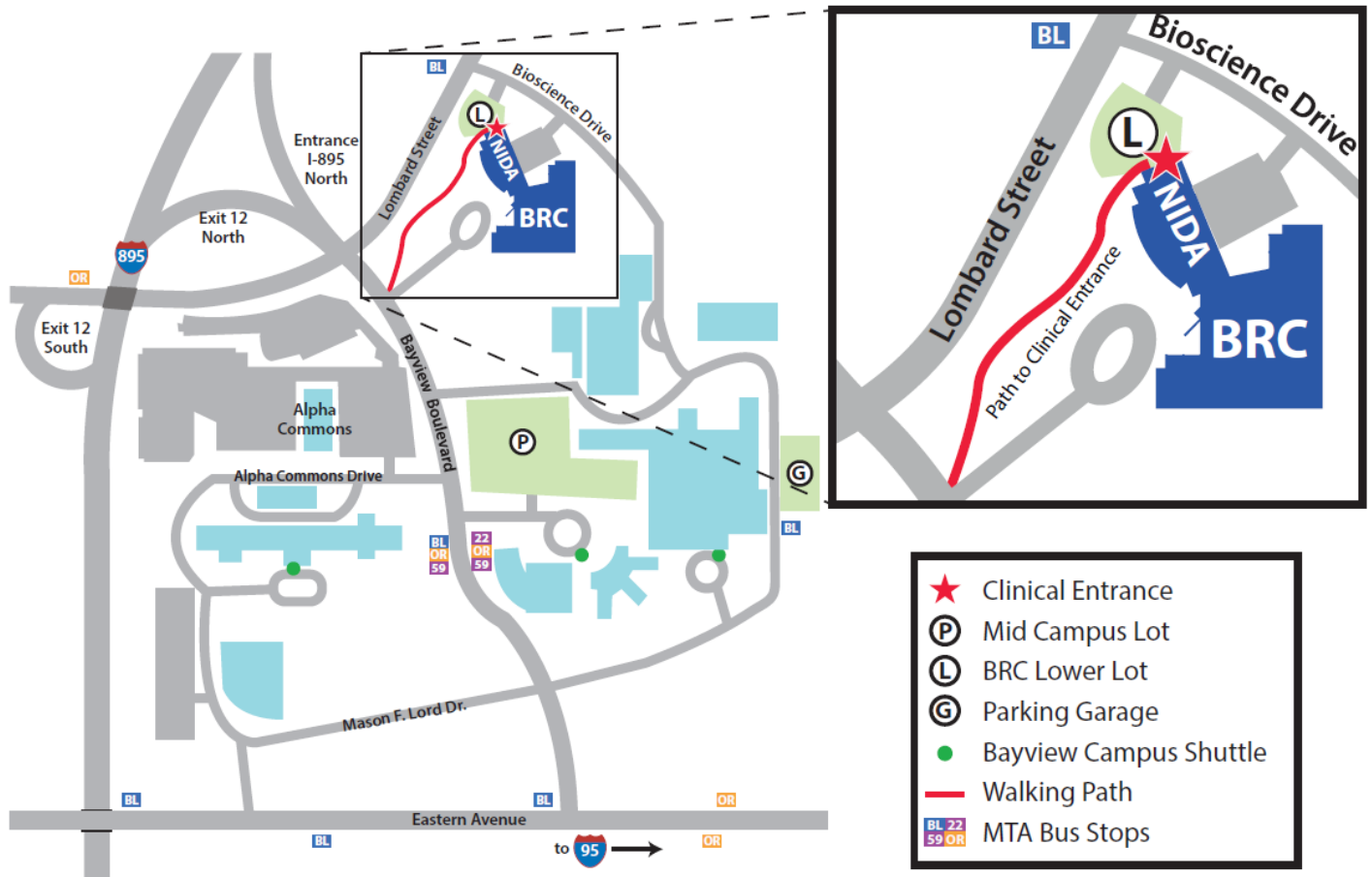
When you get to Baltimore:

- From the Penn Line – Arrive at “**West Baltimore MARC NB**” stop (2215 W Franklin St)
- You may take either **CityLink ORANGE towards ‘Or Essex’** or the **CityLink BLUE towards ‘Bl Hopkins Bayview’**. Both bus routes bring you to the Johns Hopkins Bayview Campus. Enclosed is a map that shows you where each bus stops on campus and near our building.

For route **CityLink ORANGE** get off at Bayview Blvd & Hopkins-Bayview Circle Dr which is just across the mid-campus parking lot. When you get off the bus, walk on Bayview Blvd. in the opposite direction that the bus was traveling. We are located at the end of Bayview Blvd on the right side.

For route **CityLink BLUE** get off at the last stop located at Bioscience Dr & Lombard St directly across from our building. When you get off the bus cross Lombard St. at the intersection and follow the sidewalk along Bioscience Drive to the entrance on your right and through the parking lot.

The NIDA building is at the intersection of Lombard St. and Bayview Blvd. The recruiting entrance (labeled **Clinical Entrance** on the map) it is NOT at the front of the building. There is a blacktop walkway that goes around the left side of the building (from the main entrance) through large white rocks. Follow the walkway around the hill and around the side of the building. Come into the third glass door on the right-hand side (a parking lot will be on your left). Security will be there. Please let them know you have an appointment with Recruiting, and they will direct you to the reception area.
