INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In order to be considered as an applicant in the UCA DPT professional program – international students must:

- achieve a minimum score of **600 on the TOEFL**;
- provide an **analysis of all international courses** completed in the past to include:
 - number of semester credit hours for **each class**
 - grade for **each class**
 - courses offered at UCA with which **each class** is equivalent;
- Please note that World Education Services (WES) is the preferred foreign transcript evaluation service for PTCAS applicants with non-US coursework. Only WES will be accepted beginning with the 2014-2015 application cycle.
- an overall GPA submitted by the company analyzing the previous coursework is not sufficient. **Each course** must be analyzed.
- submit **UCA Application for International Admission** including:
 - a \$50 application fee
 - copy of government issued identification
 - academic records
 - TOEFL score
 - proof of financial support for one academic year of tuition (approximately \$31,000)

- Submit an **Application to the DPT Program** through the Physical Therapy Centralized Application System (PTCAS) web site at PTCAS <http://www.ptcas.org/> as well as the
 - UCA Supplemental Application
 - Documented observation forms
 - GRE Score
 - Official transcripts
