

Italy | Floods in Marche region



- On 15 September very intense rainfall occurred throughout Marche Region (central-eastern Italy), triggering landslides, and causing flash floods and river overflow.
 - According to Civil Protection Authorities, in the afternoon-evening of 15 September, the rainfall intensity recorded at the rain gauge in Cantiano (Province of Pesaro) was 384 mm in 6 hours (419 mm in 12 hours).
 - The most affected areas by floods and landslides include the Provinces of Ancona and Pesaro Urbino, where at least 11 people died and two others are missing, while extensive damage to houses, roads and infrastructure has been reported.
