What Trove includes

- **Books and Libraries** (books, audio books, websites, monographs, scores, etc.)
- **Diaries, Letters, and Archives** (records, manuscripts, personal archives, etc.)
- **Research and Reports** (datasets)
- **Music, Audio and Video** (transcripts, interviews, oral history, movies, etc.)
- **Images, Maps, and Artefacts** (photos, illustrations, artwork, maps, etc.)
- **People and Organisations** (*no longer accepted?*)

What we can provide

- **Wikisource:** Transcripts of written works. (Wikidata.)
- **Commons:**
 - **Individual files and data pages:** images, audio, video, datasets, etc. (Structured Data on Commons.)
 - **Categories:** records, collections, etc. (Wikidata.)
- **Wikipedia:** people and places. (Wikidata.)

Selecting works

- **What is 'Australian content'?**
- **Can it be defined with Wikidata queries?**
- **Initially opt-in via `{{trove}}` template (and category).**
- **Avoid multiple entries for e.g. derivative files on Commons.**
- **Handle works that are already on Trove (regardless of originating on Wikimedia *or* other repositories)**

Workflow

- 1) Add `{{trove}}` template to a page (inc. talk and sub pages)
- 2) Page is added to category
- 3) Tool scans category and exports required metadata
- 4) Trove harvests the tool's output
- 5) Tool queries Trove for work IDs of items, and updates Wikidata/SDC

The output of `{{trove}}` changes based on the current stage in this workflow

Toolforge tool

- <https://troveau.toolforge.org>
- Creates OAI-PMH feed of everything we want to export
- Updates *Trove work ID* (P10044) on Wikidata and SDC, daily
- Publicly logs all tool activity, to help clean up data
- Imports other metadata from Trove (e.g. state libraries' catalogue IDs)

Next steps

- 1) Create `{{trove}}` template and add to existing items
- 2) Fill those with *Trove work ID* (P10044)
- 3) WMAU to sign up as Trove Partner (~\$2,000/year?)
- 4) Get NUC Symbol to identify Wikimedia (or WMAU?)
- 5) Start adding `{{trove}}` to new items
