

CIAM Scholarship Report 2020

Election of the Winner 2020

By November 15, 2019, five candidates sent in their applications for the tenth 2000 € CIAM Scholarship.

- Michal Zitnan (SVK)

To evaluate the winner, the ranking system had been used for the seventh time. Every expert - now from eight countries - provides a ranking from one to five, and the applicant with the lowest sum of points wins.

In that case, experts are in doubt whether a schoolboy or a schoolgirl needs our scholarship and rate in favour of older candidates.
