

### Jury Report on FAI International Competitions including World Cups



Schedule of competition	<p>1 week before the event, 2 judges had to withdraw due to illness and personal circumstances which left the organisers short of options for selecting a Jury. It was decided that the Jury would consist of 3 extremely experienced pilots with different Nationalities in order to deal with any potential issues or concerns over the weekend.</p> <p>Pilots briefing was held at 0830 hrs on Saturday morning with the calibration flight completed by Denis Leboullenger (FRA) who was drawn at random. After the calibration, there was a short break due to a shower passing through, after which the first pilot flew. There was then a break for a few hours due to persistent drizzle across the flying site. When the weather improved the first round of Schedule P was completed by which time the showers had dissipated. 2 more rounds of Schedule P were completed and flying was complete by 1900 hrs. Sunday began at 0900 hrs with a calibration flight for schedule F which was flown by Ian Emery (GBR) who was drawn at random. Due to only having 9 pilots, all were offered the opportunity to fly Schedule F, only Jos Kenens (BEL) declined. Flying was completed shortly after 1200 hrs.</p>
Interruptions and delays:	Schedule P round 1 had interruptions due to persistent drizzle and showers over the flying site. All other rounds were completed without delay or interruptions.
Weather:	<p>Saturday - Overcast with drizzle and heavy showers for most of the morning and early afternoon before improving with a light South Westerly wind.</p> <p>Sunday - Scattered clouds with light and variable winds.</p>
Local rules or deviations from Sporting Code:	Due to the layout and restrictions of the flying site, Competitors were instructed not to start their models until the previous pilot had vacated the landing area.
