


Declaration of Conformity according to Directive 2002/96/EC (WEEE)

On 27 January 2003 the WEEE Directive was signed by the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union.

The Directive 2002/96/EC on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) governs the take-back and obligatory marking of waste electrical and electronic equipment and has been in force since 13 August 2005.

Raytek fully complies with the WEEE Directive for the disposal of waste electrical and electronic equipment in line with the legislation applicable in the individual EU member states. Since 01 August 2005 all Raytek products leaving the factory have been marked with the  symbol.


Our products sold in Europe, including those imported from other countries, are properly registered on the Internet under www.stiftung-ear.de with the German national register for waste electric equipment (EAR). Our WEEE registration number is DE 47360378.

The European Raytek headquarters in Berlin (Germany) have signed a contract with TechProtect for recycling services. Our authorised distributors, our service department and TechProtect itself (for larger quantities) are responsible for collecting the waste electronic equipment. TechProtect organises the disposal process for Raytek and informs the EAR on the quantities and types of waste.

In addition, we ensure that all waste equipment returned to Raytek will be recycled in line the with WEEE Directive.
