

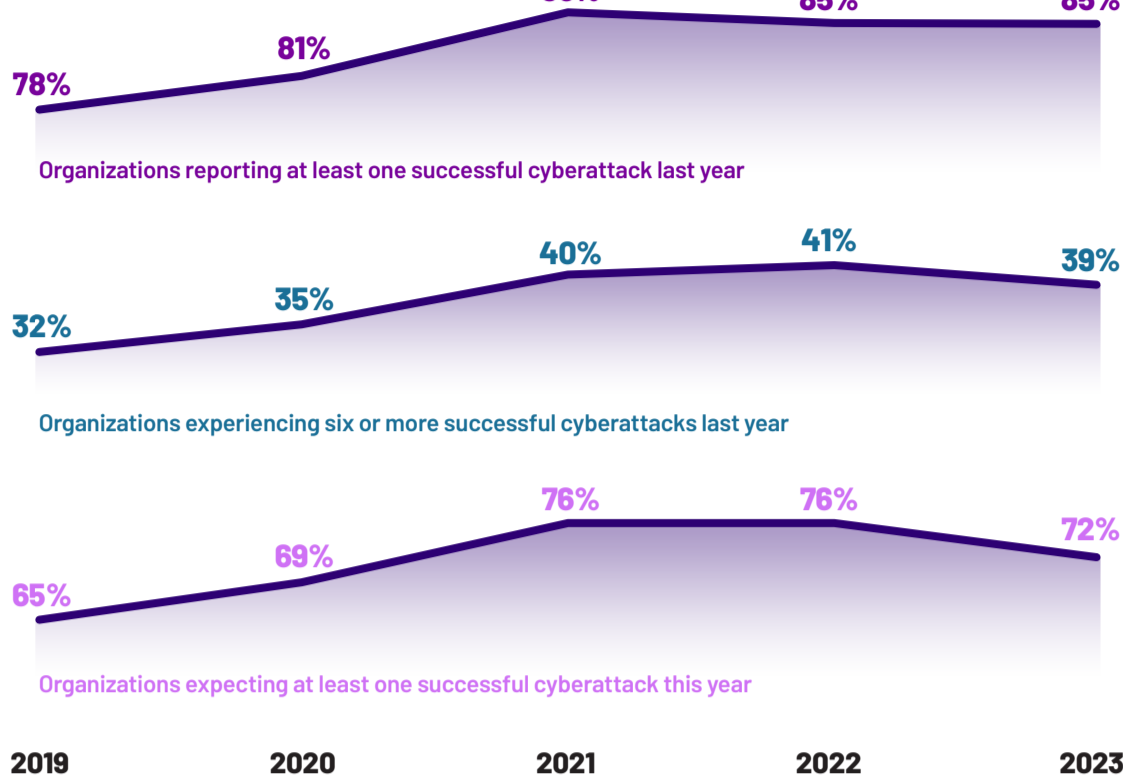

Most Challenging IT Security Functions

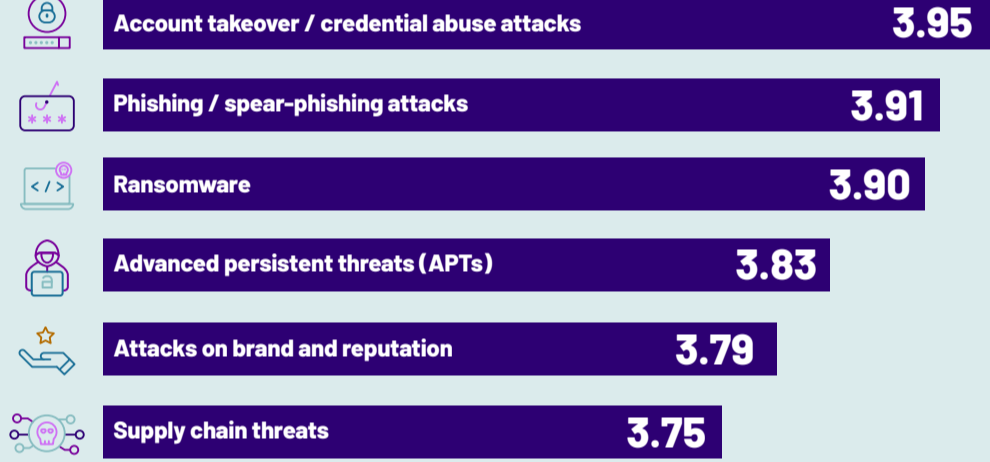
Organizations are most concerned about the adequacy of their capabilities in these areas of IT security.

These cyberthreats are among the ones that most concern IT security professionals

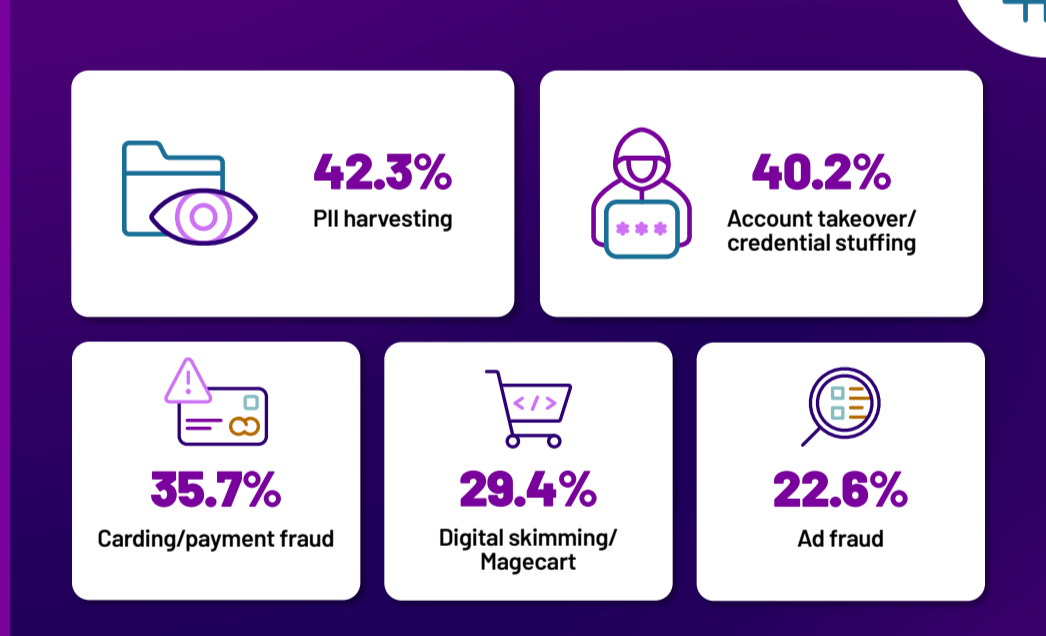
Ranked on a scale of 1 to 5, 5 being of most concern.
