Subject: INTERPOL 2017-2020 Strategic Framework

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Bali, Indonesia, from 7 to 10 November 2016 at its 85th session:

RECALLING Article 8(b) of INTERPOL's Constitution, according to which the General Assembly shall "determine principles and lay down the general measures suitable for attaining the objectives of the Organization",

BEARING IN MIND the need for INTERPOL to adjust its strategy to an ever-changing global context while pursuing its mission and objectives towards a safer world,

COMMITTED to enhancing its support to INTERPOL's 190 member countries with a view to anticipating new forms of crimes and emerging threats,

REFERRING to the insights received from member countries throughout the course of the INTERPOL 2020 reform initiative and the regional consultation process, and to the new Operating Model launched in 2015, which provides for the creation of three Global Programmes supported by Policing and Corporate Capabilities,

TAKING NOTE of the successful completion of the 2014-2016 Strategic Framework and the support expressed by member countries over the past three years,

CONSIDERING that the Executive Committee has endorsed the INTERPOL Strategic Framework 2017-2020,

APPROVES the INTERPOL Strategic Framework 2017-2020 and SUPPORTS its implementation over the next four years;

ENDORSES INTERPOL's new strategic architecture, which comprises the Strategic Framework as the overarching strategic direction of the Organization, with global programmatic strategies supported by strategies for capabilities, and delivered through regional strategies.
