



# A federal tax **REFUND** may be waiting for you

Even if you're not required to **file**

Do you work? Did a child live with you for over half of the year? Do you pay for someone in your family to attend school? If you answered YES to ANY of these questions, file your federal tax return and you may get a **REFUND** up to:

- **\$7,830 per return** for the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) or **\$632 per return** for the EITC if you don't have a child

PLUS

- **\$1,700 per child** for the Additional Child Tax Credit (ACTC)
- **\$1,000 per student** for the American Opportunity Tax Credit (AOTC)

If you claim the EITC or ACTC, the IRS can't release your refund until mid-February. Errors on the tax return can cause a delay in processing your claim for the tax credits.
