ISACA AWARDS PROGRAM

ISACA recognizes outstanding contributions that advance our professional community and exemplify our purpose and leadership. By acknowledging the individuals and achievements that have a positive impact on our global society, ISACA seeks to inspire future generations of business and technology professionals.

There are four categories of awards administered by ISACA, recognizing separate levels of achievement::

Global Achievement Awards: These are the highest awards presented by ISACA for distinguished service, exemplary achievements and contributions to advancing technology worldwide.

Hall of Fame: ISACA recognizes members who have shown exemplary dedication to advancing ISACA's purpose through volunteer service and/or member engagement activities.

Chapter Awards: These awards recognize outstanding contributions by chapters and individual chapter leaders in fulfilling the needs of ISACA and its professional community.

Certification Exam Top Scores: The top scores for the Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA), Certified Information Security Manager (CISM), Certified in the Governance of Enterprise IT (CGEIT), Certified in Risk and Information Systems Control (CRISC), and Certified Data Privacy Solutions Engineer (CDPSE) exams worldwide are recognized annually.



ISACA Technology for Humanity Award

Recognizes an individual, program or organization whose efforts in connecting with underserved communities or underrepresented individuals has helped bridge the digital divide.

For championing efforts to transform Nigeria's Federal Inland Revenue Service (FIRS) to a digitized organization, thereby bridging disparities among living standards and reducing fraud, and for supporting coding programs for women and children.

She has also headed different directorates within FIRS and served in the Federal Ministry of Industry, Trade and Investment in 2017 as the Technical Advisor in modernizing Industrial Property (IP) Registries.

Chiaka holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science and Public Administration as well as an MBA and Postgraduate Diploma in Information Systems Development and an alumna of the prestigious Lagos Business School in Lekki, Nigeria. She is also a recipient of ISACA Abuja Chapter's "SheLeadsTech" award and was named a "Corporate Woman of Excellence in Information Technology" in addition to serving as a mentor for young females seeking careers in STFM fields

ISACA Inspirational Leadership Award

Recognizes a visionary leader who has inspired organizations and professionals to advance and adapt within a digital world.

Ramona Ratiu, CISA, CISM

For inspiring work, education, mentorship, and guidance to advance current and future generations of technologists and advocating for women worldwide.

Ramona Ratiu is the Cyber Security Program Manager at Zurich Insurance Group, focusing on effective risk planning strategies as the core for strengthening, improving and maturing their cybersecurity program. In addition, she serves as an Adjunct Professor at DePaul University, where she teaches IT Risk Management principles and program development at both the graduate and undergraduate level while also voluntarily teaching ISACA certifications review courses to students and professionals from around the world.

Under Ramona's leadership, the ISACA Chicago Chapter won two prestigious awards, and she was individually selected as a recipient of the 2022 Outstanding Chapter Leader Award. She has also received accolades as a SheLeadsTech Ambassador and facilitator of the EXPERTISE program, which mentors, supports and empowers women to pursue leadership careers.





ISACA Innovative Solutions Award

Recognizes an individual or organization who has developed or utilized technology to solve business or societal challenges.

CASTLEPOINT SYSTEMS

For innovating in the area of information risk and security management with Artificial Intelligence.

Castlepoint Systems is a multi-award-winning Australian organization specializing in data protection, compliance and risk management.

In 2022, Castlepoint Systems was named RegTech of the Year and was included in the lists for the RegTech 100, CyberTech 100 and Al FinTech 100 for the second year running. CEO Rachael Greaves was also awarded the Female Entrepreneur at the 2022 RegTech Australia awards as well as Most Outstanding Woman in IT Security at the 2022 Women in Security Awards.

Castlepoint spans an entire network to register and read all data, in any system, and in any format. Using NLP, Castlepoint provides discovery across the whole environment through a single pane of glass and goes further to use rules-as-code to classify and categorise content automatically. Castlepoint is used by organisations to find and relate high-value and high-risk information, and to automatically apply compliance and security rules to data with Al. It tracks and permanently retains all events on all items in the network to support audit, investigations, alerts, and reporting. It does this invisibly to normal users and with no impact on source systems or data.
