

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Leeds (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (No.2) Order 2023

Made - - - - 23 March 2023

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Leeds City Council (“the council”) in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”) has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations:

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86, 98 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Leeds (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (No.2) Order 2023.

(2) Subject to paragraph (3) below, this Order shall come into force on 1st April 2023.

(3) Article 7 of this Order shall come into force on the day this Order is made.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Leeds (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (No.2) Order 2023” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number.

Effect of Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the 2007 Act relevant to any provision of this Order.

Dissolution of parish council for the parish of Ledston

4. The parish council for the parish of Ledston shall be dissolved.

Abolition of the parish of Ledston

5. The parish of Ledston shown edged red on the map shall be abolished.

Electoral register

6. The registration officer for the district shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Transfer of property, rights and liabilities

7. All land, property, rights and liabilities of the parish council for the parish of Ledston, (including for the avoidance of doubt, any property conveyed or transferred to, or described as vesting in the parish council for the parish of Ledston Luck), and including in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing), the property described in Schedules 1 and 2 shall transfer from the parish council for the parish of Ledston to the council on 31 March 2023.

Order date

8. 1st April 2023 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.
